## **ORDER**

The details of the Resolution No. 2 is as under;

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT the Interim Resolution
Professional CA Tejas Shah, having IP Registration No.
IBBI/IPA-001/IP-P00089/2017-18/10185 and is hereby
authorized to file with the Hon'ble NCLT, Mumbai Bench the
decision of the Committee of Creditors to liquidate the
Corporate Debtor.

2. Subsequently, in the second COC meeting held on 09.01.2020, the COC passed a resolution No. 3 regarding the appointment of liquidator, the details of which are as under;

"to recommended the name of the Liquidator to Adjudicating Authority for appointment as Liquidator

..Resolved that Mr. Bijendrakumar Jha, having Registration No. IBBI/IPA-001/IP-P00712/2017-2018/11227 be and is hereby proposed by majority of the members of the COC for recommendation to Adjudicating Authority for appointment as the Liquidator of the Corporate Debtor."

Voted in favour: UBI, IDBI, INDUSIND, Axis bank (100 % of voting power)

Voted against: Nil

Abstained against: Nil

The Resolution has been assented by requisite majority of members of COC and hence passed."

- 3. The COC in that meeting also decided to pay the liquidation fee of Rs. 1,00,000/- p.m. to the liquidator so appointed.
- 4. In M.A. 382/2020, the IRP wants the relief relating to the payment of certain dues and out of the expenses to the IRP which has not been approved by the COC. This Bench directs that the matter may be considered by the COC first and thereafter an M.A. regarding the payment if any to the IRP. This Bench turther wife
